FACCES successfully launched a new membership format that has grown enrollment by 216% YTD.



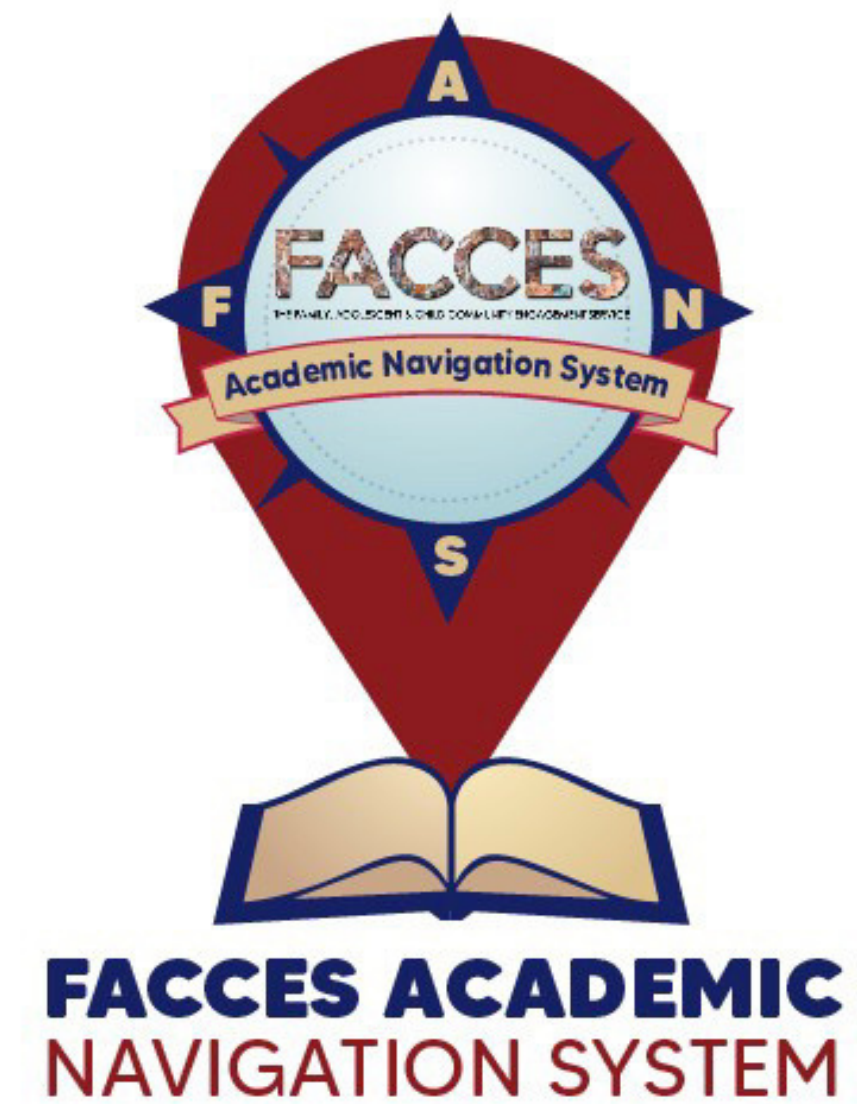

FOOD THERAPY



The “Food Therapy” program provides an opportunity for families to enjoy the tradition of cooking together. The food used to create these healthy meals are food items and ingredients distributed at the Fresh Market Festival.

All family members during each session work together to prepare the meal. Participants learn healthy food recipes and food sourcing from a professional chef.

Families learn skills to be used in their own kitchens that reinforce bonds and foster togetherness.
